

Weekly Reflection: Ascension Sunday - Year B - 2018

"He ascended into heaven..."

Did you know that "Goodbye" is derived from "God Be with You"?

So that while we think of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus as bidding his disciples goodbye because he is now taken "from their sight", it must be understood that it is not to separate Himself from them but that it was a necessary prelude to a profound union, a union that would last. Because now, Jesus is looking forward into being with them permanently as he promised: "I am with you always, until the end of the age."! And thus, we can only but welcome this moment as one that should fill us with great joy.

That is why Pope Benedict XVI pointed out "The meaning of Christ's Ascension expresses our belief that in Christ the humanity that we all share has entered into the inner life of God in a new and hitherto unheard-of way. It means that man has found an everlasting place in God." Jesus did not leave us behind but had taken us into the innermost life of God. The Mystery of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus tells us that "Where the Master is, there will His servant be."

How faithful have we been to this great dignity the Lord is offering? If we are, then we must be carrying out the task He had entrusted to us: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature."


