# Weekly Reflection: 10th Sunday of Ordinary Time - Cycle B

"Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it."

Part of Jesus' becoming human was to be born into a human family. And knowing the sacrifices that each one of the Holy Family has to go through, they can only have been sustained by their great love and concern for one another.

Thus, it will be farthest from the mind of Jesus not to recognize the significant role of the family in the life of every disciple. Jesus will be the first to affirm the significance of Mary's motherhood and therefore she was to be blest for it. But the Lord also know that the true strength of human family lies in their willingness to hear the word of God and live by it. And this will be their truest blessing! "Blessed are those who hear the word of God and obev it."

## Sacramental Marriage Validation Celebration (continued)

St. Joseph will have a centennial event of a Mass Marriage Validation with Bishop Silva on March 23, 2018 at 2:00 pm at St. Joseph Church. Couples who wish to have a sacramental marriage in the church or wish to have their marriage annulled should contact their parish priest. St. Joseph couples can contact Rose Nunogawa at 935-1465.

Pope Francis recently streamlined the process for a declaration of nullity to make the process shorter. He also eliminated the fees. If a person is able to prove in this process that their prior marital bond was invalid for some reason, the he or she can marry in the Catholic Church or validate a current civil marriage.

Marriage Preparation will include:

Prenuptial interview Completion of documentation Communication Session Seminar on Marriage

Sacramental Session with Parish Priest

Civil Marriages will need: Civil Marriage Certificate and Baptismal Certificates (for Catholics)

Couples Living Together will need: Baptismal Certificate Document (for Catholics)

Divorced Couples will need:

Annulment number or certificate (from Tribunal & Canonical Office)

Divorce decree (from lawyer)

Marriage certificate (from State Health Dept)

Baptismal certificate (for Catholics)
