#### Weekly Reflection: Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion – 2019 "Crucify him! Crucify him!"

Today as we celebrate Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, we enter the greatest and most important week of the liturgical year – the Holy Week. Holy because as St. Paul says: it is the commemoration of the "great mysteries of our redemption" – the Passion, Death and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus that brought as our salvation. Jesus is to restore us to our original holiness.

And specifically, this Sunday, we commemorate the solemn entrance of Jesus to Jerusalem followed by the reading of the Passion of our Lord. Initially the crowd joyfully welcomed him with palm branches while shouting Hosannas. But this was short lived. Not even a week later, they will also shout "Crucify Him!".

Let us make the succeeding days holy by reflecting on the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Let us pray for the grace that we be not afraid to follow Him on the way of the cross and be ready to die to ourselves that He may live in us. Let us also humbly fall on our knees, examine the many ways we have betrayed Jesus through our sins, make a good and sincere confession, and ask for the gift to be a faithful disciple.

#### GOOD FRIDAY, 6AM STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Weather permitting, this year St. Joseph Church will offer an outdoor Stations of the Cross at 6am on Good Friday. Stations of the Cross will also be offered in the usual way at 1pm. A sign up sheet for volunteer readers, cross and candle bearers is available in the sacristy. Join us on this mini-pilgrimage as we accompany Jesus in his final journey to the Crucifixion and our redemption.

#### **EASTER VIGIL**

Easter Vigil begins with the Lucernarium, the blessing of the new fire and preparation of the Paschal Candle. While the church is in darkness, a fire is lit and blessed near the main entrance of the church. After preparing the Paschal Candle, the priest lights it from the new fire and it is carried in procession to stand in front of the sanctuary. As the candle moves forward, ministers share its light with the congregation using small candles. We invite those who can to gather at the main entrance of the church for the Lucernarium. A monitor will be set up in front of the sanctuary so that those who re-

main inside may also share in the rite. Please be aware that the church will be dark for the rite and use caution when moving to/from the pews.
