Weekly Reflection: Easter Sunday - 2019 Alleluia! The Lord is Risen!

After forty days of absence in our liturgy, we once again with great joy are called to sing: ALLELUIA. It comes from the Hebrew word: Hallel which means "Praise God!" and for us it is to praise God for the Lord is Risen, which is the great mystery that we celebrate this Easter!

But what does Easter and consequently that the Lord is Risen mean for everyday life of a believer? In our everyday life, Easter means experiencing the power of Jesus changing a great tragedy in our lives into a glorious new beginning. Or put int another way, Easter is recognizing that the Love of God triumphs over all the evil in the world. It is therefore the ever assuring hope that God breathes on us. Just as it was experience by the disciples who thought everything was lost when Jesus died that fateful Good Friday. Now when the sun rose that first Easter morning, Jesus rose with it and so did the hope of the disciples when they saw Him fully alive. They were actually brought back to life and became the witnesses of the risen Lord. And everywhere they preached, the power of Easter began to work miracles in the lives of people. And so it is for us today. Easter is the good news that the love of God will always and certainly will prevail.

And yet, the resurrection is and will remain as mysterious to us today as it was to the early church. The empty tomb tells us very little on what and how it happened. But one thing it proclaims is that the tomb is not the place for the risen Lord and so it will be for all those who put their faith in him.



ST. JOSEPH CHURCH COMMEMORATIVE CENTENNIAL STILL AVAILABLE


The commemorative book celebrating the 100th year anniversary of the dedication of St. Joseph Church of Hilo is still available for purchase! Featuring a historical time-


