

"I have come to bring fire upon the earth and how I wish it were already kindled. Do you think I have come to bring peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division."

What has happened to good and gentle shepherd that we are so used to. His tone seems to be very fierce and aggressive in his exhortation. But is it not more of an impassioned and dedicated teacher who would not water down the cost of discipleship? After all, is he not the prophet who speaks the Word of God even when it hurts? Is He not the Christ, who spoke the truth and had to suffer the consequence for doing so? But so be it if only because we stand up for Christ and the Kingdom of God! **Our Lord Jesus will be our strength!**


