

Programs for the Youth and Young Adults

Youth leaders continued to encourage youth and young adults to join ministries as well as participate in many events at St. Joseph Church. Much efforts are needed to secure the mission of the church is sustained in individuals as well as within families.

Faith Formation, Evangelization and Leadership Training for parishioners, volunteers and Ministers

Leaders, staff, volunteers, ministers and parishioners were provided various informative, interactive and foundational training sessions to develop Stewardship as a Way of Life at St. Joseph, our Spiritual Growth and Reflection of our Faith and Actions, Concern for others in the church and the community.

Campaign to support Church projects – 100th year Dedication of the Church, 150th year of St. Joseph School and facilities, Parish Hall, upkeep and maintenance of church building and rectory, and various approved programs/projects of the parish.

Ministries under the Stewardship Pillars of Hospitality, Prayer, Faith Formation and Service accomplished the ministry goals outlined in the 2015-2020 Parish Pastoral Plan.

- *All ministries focused on the celebration of St. Joseph Church Centennial: A Community of Disciples, Stewards of the Gospel, Witness to Jesus; Published St. Joseph's Centennial Book, Held St. Joseph's Cultural Anniversary Celebration.

A welcoming and beautiful church of parishioners and faithful priests

Ministry teams worked collaboratively to accomplish their ministry goals. Ministries submitted their calendar of events for the master calendar as well as implemented a facilities request form.

Protocols developed and continue to be established and refined for ministry guidelines, church safety, communication procedures and deadlines, etc.

A variety of media was used to communicate with parishioners and continue to keep up on effective practices. "My Parish App" was launched and utilized at St. Joseph

The Restored Order of Sacraments increased enrollments in Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation through our Religious Education Programs as well as minister/catechize the 'Ohana members of the participants. There were significant efforts made to evangelize & catechize to the students and their families enrolled at St. Joseph School especially those who sought Sacraments of Initiation as well as connect them to parish life after sacraments.

The number of couples who were prepared for marriage increased as well as their attendance for both engaged and marriage encounters. Marriage renewals also increased during the centennial Celebration.

Many prayerful and faith formation events including rosary, novena, Bible study, etc. were held throughout the years that supported our spiritual development.

There were increased opportunities for participation in service and fellowship through Choir, Eucharistic Ministry, Altar services, Sacristan, Hospitality Ministers, and other faith filled experiences. Diverse music choirs provided music at masses. Cultural and children choirs increased member participation.

Outreach services provided monthly hot meals to the community. Active involvement with non-government agencies have increased to support the needs in the community.

Grieving families were shown love and support from our priests, staff and parishioners during their time of loss.

Many diverse cultural groups participated in church activities, choir, programs and parish celebrations.

Pastoral care and guidance from the bishop and diocese have supported the efforts to achieve our Parish Pastoral goals. Collaboration between all Vicariate parishes Islandwide fostered cooperation and partnerships throughout the years.

Our priests, staff, ministry leaders, PPAC and Stewardship worked collaboratively to address the goals of the Parish Pastoral Plan and the needs of the Church.




