#### Feast of the Holy Family – Year A - 2019


#### "Let the word of Christ dwell in you.."

#### **Report to Parish:**

Overall the bottom line of the income and expense for your St. Joseph Parish improved for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2019. We broke even. While regular collections declined a bit, other regular collections (special individual contribution, weddings, funerals and other such activities) increased. The big jump in revenues subject to GET represents the sale of the Centennial Book. There are more if anyone is interested to have one for themselves, family or friends. Overall, income increased 11%.

With regards to expenses the decrease in wages relates to not having a maintenance person on staff and the Parish thanks all volunteers who have stepped up to keep our facilities in top shape. Yes, more needs to be done. The big jump in repair & maintenance mostly relates to the painting of the Church and other improvements for the 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday Celebration. Fundraising expenses increases includes expenditures for the 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday Celebration. While the Celebration caused a jump in expenses, Parishioners shared their treasure to make ends meet.

The other major expense is Contributions and Assessments. The net income from the convent across from St. Joseph School continues to be committed to the School. Deductions are made only to reimburse the Parish for the corresponding insurance costs. While there was some relief in the parish assessment payable

to the diocese, in this fiscal year that assessment increased by over 20%. This is attributed to increased expenses incurred by the diocese to cover extraordinary expenditures.

Finally, contributions to Temporarily Restricted Funds incudes the repair and maintenance fund and special collections where the income is targeted to specific activities and accounts. This is not taxed by the diocese. The increased revenue in this account helped cover the improvements made to Parish property and buildings.


Repair and maintenance projects for the Parish for this fiscal year include items such as the new rug in the church, improved hot water for the priest residence and other needed activities coordinated by the repair & maintenance committee.
