$\textit{Weekly Reflection:} \quad \textbf{4}^{th} \; \textbf{Sunday of ordinary Time} - \textbf{Year} \; \textbf{C}$

"...no prophet is accepted in his own native place."

Accepting God's words is a challenge that confronted not only the people in the bible but also for us today. Jesus has to contend with the prejudices of his own people, who found it difficult to put their faith in Him. They could not accept that Jesus is providing an opening for those who are not part of the Jewish circle to be part of the Kingdom of God. But we are no different from the people of Jesus' time. Our prejudices and biases hinder us from recognizing the presence of God in our midst. Sadly the Lord puts it: **no prophet is accepted** in his own native place.

Today's gospel alert us on the possibility that God's revelation and truth is waiting to be disclose to us within the most ordinary events of our daily life and amongst the most ordinary people that we meet along the way. Do we hear God speaking to us in the beauty of creation, in the innocent smile of a child, in the familiar humdrum of our everyday chores, in the silent plea for forgiveness of those who hurt us, in the struggles to be faithful, in the joy of reaching out to others?






