

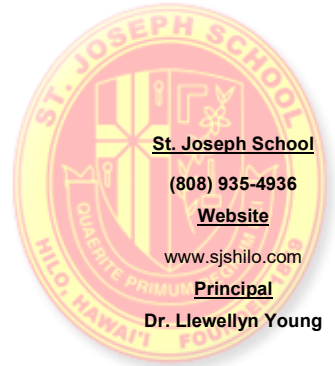

Weekly Reflection: Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time – Cycle C (2019)

“Put out into the deep water...”

Fishing is sounds fun but it is not easy. Sometimes you catch more and there are days that you get nothing. What is necessary is patience. So that when We hear in the gospel today Jesus saying to St. Peter, “Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men.”, he was both giving him an encouragement as well as a warning. Bringing people back to the Church will not be an easy task. One needs a lot of patience and understanding.t.

But it all begins by not getting afraid to go out into the deep. "Put out into the deep water, and let down the nets for a catch," Jesus tells Peter shortly after meeting him. But going out into the deep water entails a great risk and uncertainty. Here normal calculation doesn't make sense. Here one is not in control. Yes, in the deep water, we let go and let God be in control.

And in our life, these deep waters are God-space. We are called to trust God in new ways in deep water in a way that we learn to "walk by faith and not by sight."

Like Peter, in the Presence of God, we are brought to face our unworthiness.

And that is when we know that in this mission entrusted by the Lord, everything is Grace!

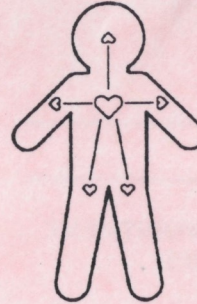

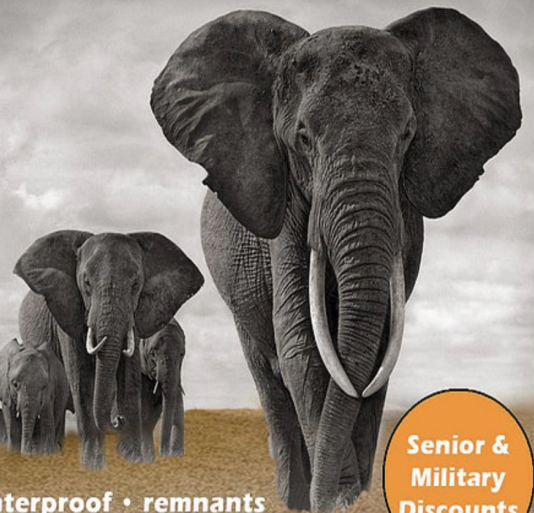
