Weekly Reflection: **Feast of the Baptism of the Lord – 2019**

“You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.”

Today is the last day for the Christmas Season with the celebration of the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. For Jesus it marks the beginning of his public ministry.

This feast invites us to reflect on the meaning of our own Baptism. For many Catholics, Baptism is just one religious ceremony, a special one yes but last only for a day. In fact, many do not even remember the day of their baptism. But the truth is, Baptism effects a fundamental change in our identity. From being just the child of our parents, we become children of God. And with Jesus, we are invited to rejoice in that singular affirmation:

“You are my beloved Son (Daughter); with you I am well please.”

We are God’s beloved children. And hopefully affirmed in love, we respond in love and become a channel of the love of God for our brothers and sisters. We are graced therefore to carry out with Jesus the mission of bringing His Good News. And like Jesus, who anchored His identity in the Father’s love, nothing is too small to be taken for granted and nothing is too vast that is unsurmountable.

As we celebrate today our *belovedness*, may we also be a channel of the Father, in affirming the belovedness of every one of God’s children.

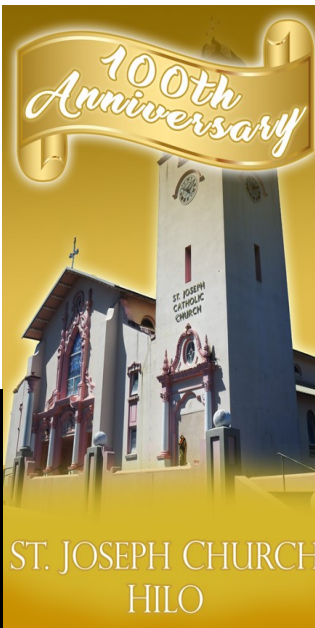

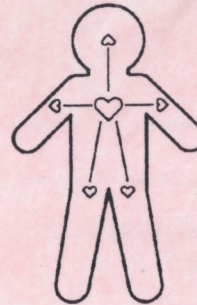
