Weekly Reflection: 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C – 2019

"Do whatever He tells you."

We are back to Ordinary Time. But that does not mean we also put to shelves the Spirit the past Christmas has blessed us. Rather we are called to let that Spirit to move us in embracing the mission that the Lord has set before us the way the Lord embraced his mission as witnessed to us in this Sunday's Gospel.

St. John called this episode as the as the beginning of his signs at Cana. It was not called miracle but sign. But signs of what? And we can only surmise that it is all about signs of the Kingdom of God being present in our midst. Jesus is the presence of that Kingdom of God!

Specifically, at Cana, Our Lord is presented as entering into people's troubles and how He suffices in every difficulty and at the end transforming us and our situation into an experience of grace – the way he transformed the water into wine.

The story in the Gospel would have stood with Jesus doing everything by himself but for some reason it also included the participation of Mary as one interceding in behalf of the couple at Cana. And her words certainly spoke everything for the people of her time as well as for us today: "Do whatever he tells you."

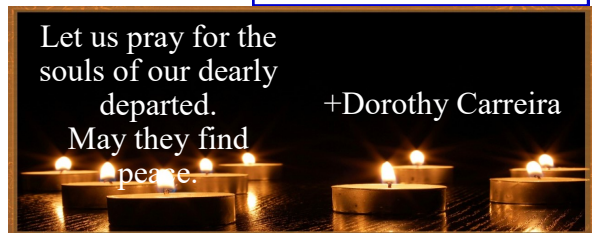

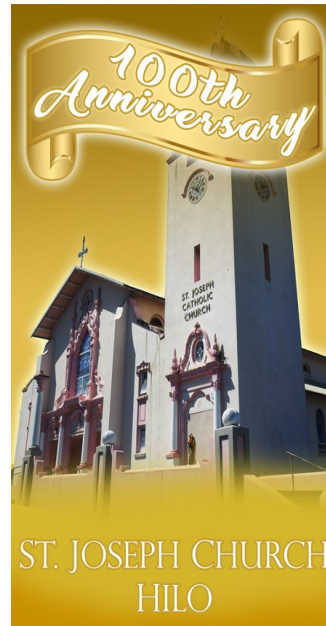

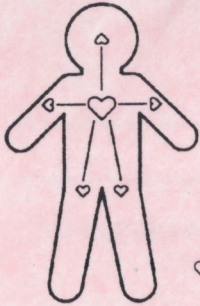
