Weekly Reflection: Trinity Sunday – 2019

"In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of The Holy Spirit."

In a world that has put the emphasis on the "I" and "Me" and "Mine", to-day's feast of the Holy Trinity - "of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit" - stands as a direct contrast. And while we are so used to dealing with the Holy Trinity as a profound mystery of our faith, it might be helpful that we approach it as the manifestation of the loving relationship between the Father and Son and the Holy Spirit that should be the inspiration and example of every Christian community – the family, the basic ecclesial communities and the Church.

The bond of unity between the persons of the Trinity is fashioned in love at its fullest. It is one that is borne out of a total giving of self which washes away all greed, selfishness and conceit. And this is the love that Jesus has shown to us and this is the kind of love that he desires that we share with one another.

The next time we make the sign of the cross, let us be reminded that not only were we saved by the cross of Christ but that we belong wholly to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit – the Most Holy Trinity.

All things come to an end. Even the best and happiest ones. When we surpass a mission, when a task is done... when we survived difficulties, we sigh with relief, breathing out a silent prayer of thanksgiving.


