Weekly Reflection: "Give them some food yourselves."

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Bpody and Blood of Christ this Sunday, I am sure many of us wish that Jesus will re-enact here and now the miracles he did in the Gospel - like the feeding of the five thousand. Then there will be less hungry people. But we will be missing a very important point of the gospel if we do not take seriously Jesus insistence to the disciples: "Give them some food yourselves." They have to participate in the unfolding of the miracle. And so must we. So when was the last time we offered to feed a hungry person?

We also recognize that the miracle was told using the same words Jesus used in the Last Supper, in the institution of the Eucharist. And so we can also conclude that the feeding of the crowd was a Eucharistic feeding. In our life of faith, we are challenge not to consider the Eucharist as merely static ritual. No, the Eucharist is dynamic; the Eucharist moves to do something creative and life-giving. Our participation and reception of the Eucharist should impel us to bring Jesus to people and make His presence felt. This is our commitment when we say Amen as we receive "the Body of Christ." We are called to make real "Christ's Body" in the way we live and love.
