


## St. Joseph Church

#### 1. Put up an image of Mary:

You can decorate your home, or your place of work with an altar, a statue, or painting/image of Mother Mary

2. Read Bible Passages on Virgin Mary:

You can read about her Annunciation, the birth of Jesus, the Presentation in the Temple and Mary at the Foot of the Cross

3. Pray the Rosary:

Praying the Rosary is one of the Main prayers of the Church. Virgin Mary herself taught St. Dominic how to do it.

4. Participate in a Marian Procession:

Marian processions are a tradition that is still alive in some countries. It involves walking with an image of Mary and saying Marian Prayers & Songs. This is something you can do as a family around your home.

#### 5. Receive the Sacraments:

Make sure you receive the sacraments, especially Confession & the Eucharist, where Jesus waits for us with open arms.

6. Perform Works of Mercy:

You can help a pregnant mother in need or visit a nursing home, where you may find older women who feel lonely or abandoned.

7. Evangelize:

It is important to remind others how much Virgin Mary loves them and teach them to pray to the Mother of God, taking our messages straight to God for us.

#### 8. Give someone a Marian Gift:

It is recommended to give someone a Marian Medal of the Scapular of Our Lady of Carmen, blessed by a priest.

Weekly Reflection: Fifth Sunday of Easter – 2019
"As I have loved You!"

Taken from his farewell discourse during the Last Supper, Jesus exhorts his disciples, "And now I give you a new commandment: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. If you have love for one another, then everyone will know that you are my disciples". But what makes this commandment new?

It is new because Jesus' love is now the standard and measure of the way we will love. He loved us to the end, he loved without counting the cost, he loved that we may have life in us. So that even if Jesus departs, the disciples can continue to be His followers and keep His Spirit alive through this command: "This is how all will know that you are my disciples: if you have love for one another." We keep the Spirit of Jesus alive by the love that we share with one another.

To be a disciple of Jesus therefore, is to make our witness of loving our primary task.




