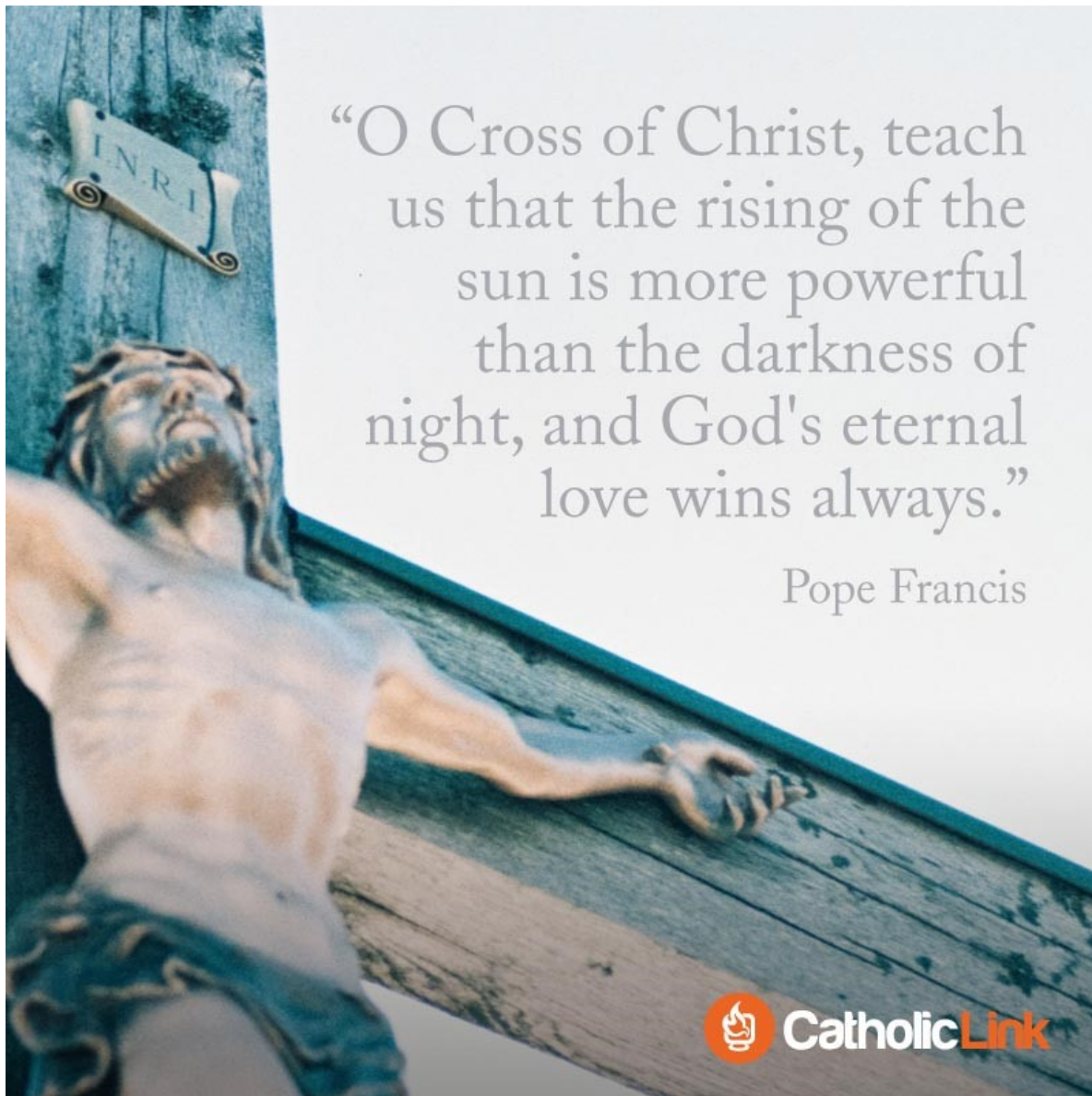

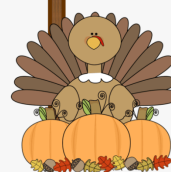

For God is the God of the living

As we approach the end of the liturgical year, we are invited to reflect on the reality of life after death. **Is there really a life after death? If ever, what form does it take? How do we prepare for it?**

In the Gospel, The Sadducees who do not believe in life after death tried to present the complexity of such an idea of the resurrection of the dead. Jesus tried to respond by explaining that first, there is absolutely no comparison between life in this world with the life in the next. The children of the resurrection do not die anymore and live like angels. And second, God is a God of the living, and not of the dead. And thus, He calls us His children to share in His divine life.

Belief in the resurrection of the dead and the life after reminds us that we are not created to belong to this world but that we are just passing through. Hence, we should not be attached to anything that this world offers instead let us take the offer of Jesus, the Divine Bridegroom, to us of a life of intimate communion in heaven with Him. **There with the Divine Bridegroom, we shall find our eternal happiness.**

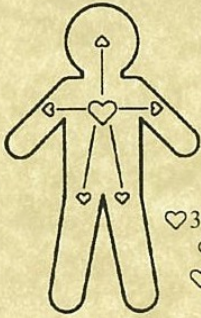
