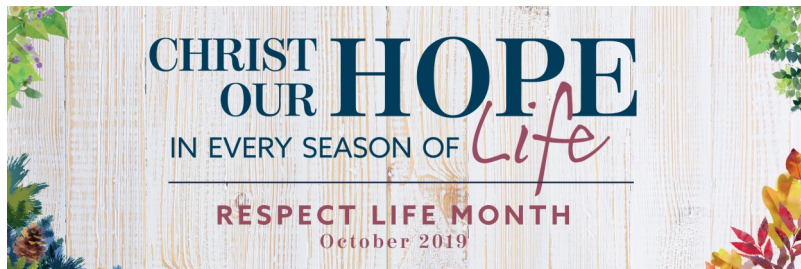

Persevere in Prayer

In this time of instant oatmeal and coffees, how many times have we heard people say they quit praying because their prayers are not being answered anyway. Many have the mistaken notion that God is supposed to give a prompt response to our prayer – which usually means we get what we want. ***Sorry but God does not work that way.*** While He certainly answers all our prayers but according to his own ways and in His own time.

In today's parable, Jesus teaches his disciples the need of persevering in prayer. Like the widow in the parable, our perseverance will spell the difference. Prayer requires faith, but it also requires perseverance. When Jesus tells us to pray continually and not to lose heart, Jesus to trust in His Father, who is also Our Father. And when we trust, we do not ask him to do what we want but by constant prayer we learn to align our will to His. And we can be assured that God's response to our prayer can only but for our ultimate good.

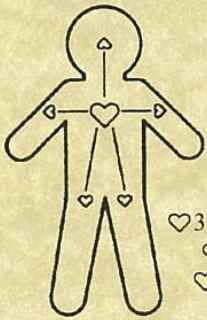
