"God, have mercy on me, a sinner."


There are many occasions that bring us to prayer. There are many ways of praying. And while it is meant to be a moment of encounter with God, our prayer, especially how we pray, reveals who we truly are!

Jesus in the parable condemned Pharisee for his self-righteous attitude as reflected in his prayer: "O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity — greedy, dishonest, adulterous." Obviously, the Pharisee was extolling himself before God. He was in effect saying, he does not need God's mercy. While the tax collectors on the other hand approached God beating his breast, and pleading "God, have mercy on me, a sinner." Acknowledging his sinfulness he is throwing himself totally before God's mercy.

At the end of their prayer, the tax collector "went home justified," — God had reconciled him to Himself — but not the Pharisee. How true, "The prayer of the lowly pierces the clouds; it does not rest till it reaches its goal."

To be pleasing to God. we approach Him humbly and lovingly.




