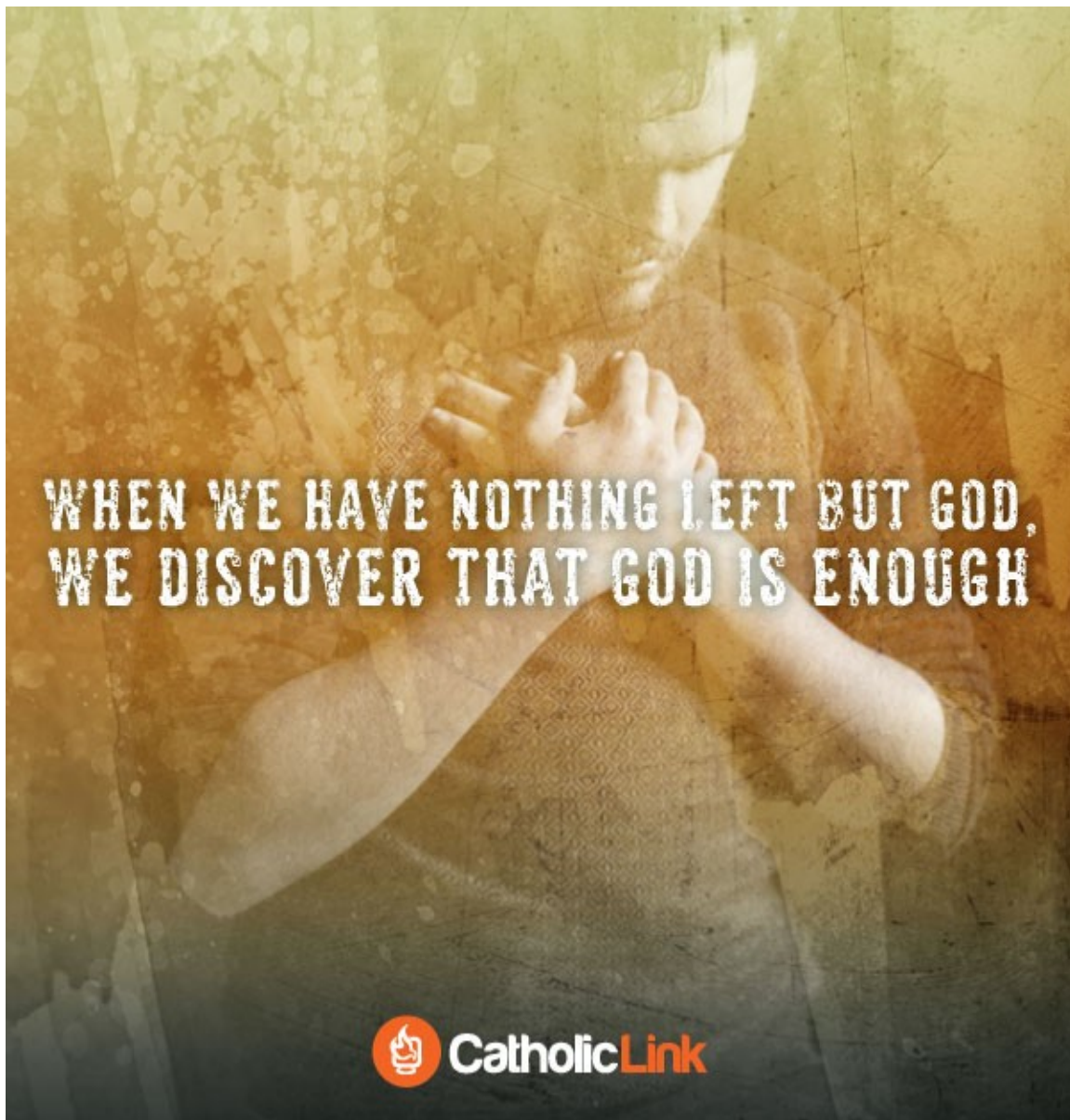

St. Luke portrays Jesus as one who loves to dine with all kinds of people – his disciples, tax collectors, friends, or just with the multitude. But always he took these meals to be an opportunity to preach the Kingdom of God. This time he is having a meal in the home of a Pharisee.

And noticing how the guests are scampering for places of honor, Jesus exhorts his listeners to choose rather the lowest place with the possibility of the host inviting the person to move up higher. But more than a lesson on social grace, Jesus wants us to realize that only with childlike humility can we truly serve others and thus be able to dine in the Kingdom of God.

And this brings us to his second lesson of inviting those who will not be able to invite us in return. Because in so doing, we reach out to those who have no one to turn to but God, Himself. And thus, we become God’s instrument in speaking to these people that while the world might have forgotten them, God has not!

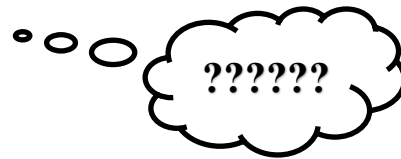

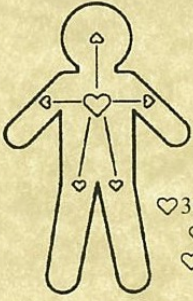
