



23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time – 2019 "If you come to me..."

In every moment of our lif, we are called to make a choice. And every choice we make, makes who we are. So if we want to change, we just have to make a different choice.

Thus, it is important that we discern carefully on important matters of life. And what could be more important than the life that awaits us in eternity. But to desire life eternal is first to choose to follow Christ with our whole person. And this is the point that Jesus is making with His disciples in this Sunday's parable – "If you come to me..."

The first parable is about a choice whether to build or not a tower. One must make sure he has the resources to finish it otherwise he will suffer the humiliation for staring what he cannot finish. The second parable is about a king who has the choice whether to wage war or not. One whoever must make sure he has the capacity to win the war otherwise it will be wise for him to negotiate to save the lives of his people.

When one choose to be a disciple of Jesus, he must be ready to face the consequences of discipleship, "Those who do not carry their own cross and come after me cannot be my disciples" (Lk. 14:27). Jesus becomes the ultimate standard. He becomes number one. Everything else takes second place.
