"...whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."


Revealing what his mission will be: That he will suffer severely and will die but only to be raised on the third day, Peter could not accept that such things could ever happen to Jesus. Unknowingly Peter's desire to prevent Jesus from any suffering would be impending God's plan.

But Jesus reminded Peter who was in command when He reprimanded him, "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." This was exactly how the devil in the desert tried to tempt Jesus.

For Jesus embracing the cross was to embrace the will of the Father. This was the way to defeat the curse of human subjection from the power of sin and death. And as he is willing to embrace the way of the cross so must a disciple of the Lord: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me." This is the only way a disciple must tread to share in the glory that is Jesus'. For losing one's life for the Lord's sake is the only way to find it!

Thus, for us to be called Jesus' disciples, we also have to embrace our own cross so as to attain our eternal glory. From the start and unlike in Jeremiah's case, Jesus told His disciples what future awaited them.

- YOU WILL RECEIVE COMMUNION ON THE HANDS ONLY TO PROTECT YOU, THE MINISTER AND THOSE WHO RECEIVE AFTER YOU.
- . WHEN YOU COME FORWARD FOR COMMUNION, WEAR YOUR MASK OR FACE COVERING. WHEN RECEIVING: REMOVE YOUR FACE COVERING WHEN THE USHER INSTRUCTS, FLATTEN YOUR HANDS, CONSUME, COVER YOUR FACE AGAIN THEN RETURN TO YOUR SEAT
