

Finally, we come to the last Sunday of our Advent preparation and will soon be celebrating the Birth of Our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

And our Gospel reminds us that such grace-filled moment in human history happened because Mary gave her consent to the plan of God. Mary's "yes" ushered the beginning of a new era – the Anno Domini – the Year of the Lord! And as it is true with Our Blessed Mother, so it is with each and every one of us. God is counting on our yes to His Divine plan if we will likewise see the unfolding of His Kingdom in our midst. It might not be as dramatic with an angel appearing before us, but could be just a simple voice from an ordinary individual reminding us to be faithful to the truth. Or to the voice of a stranger that begs for your compassion. Or to the cry of creation for your loving concern. Or to be ready to forgive and to ask forgiveness. Indeed God can speak to us in different ways. We just have to be ready to say our YES to him.

Yes Christmas is about the grace of the coming of Jesus into our world, but Christmas is also a testimony to "humanity-being-graced" to take part in God's plan.




