

"... the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light."

Except probably while watching a movie in a cinema or going to bed, we long for that light that will dispel the darkness. And this is how St. Matthew describes the beginning of the public ministry of Jesus: "... the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light; on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death light has arisen." A revelation which Our Lord has made known to us at the moment of our baptism when we are presented with the light of Christ and challenge to keep its flame burning through out our lives.

In a world encompassed by darkness, Our Lord Jesus is the Light that comes to dispel it. And he does so by proclaiming the need for repentance so as to inaugurate the Kingdom of Heaven. Repentance to bring to the light of Christ those areas of our lives that have been dwelling in darkness of sin. All his life Jesus dedicated in illuminating our world with the grace and love that comes from His Father with the hope that we will be able to confront the evil of sin and with His grace overcome it. As disciples of our Lord, we are called not only to live in the light of Christ but also to bring that light of Christ to others. This is the mission entrusted to us.

Blessing Candles on the Feast of the Presentation Feb. 2, 2020

Forty days after Christmas the infant Jesus was presented in the temple of Jerusalem In the Church this day is celebrated on February 2, forty days after Jesus' birth. This day may be thought of as a festival of light. We hear about the light in today's gospel. We see it in the candles that are blessed and carried. We receive it as did St. Simeon. That light is Christ himself, our salvation and life. The final bless-

ing given at the end of the liturgy incorporates the theme and symbolism of this light.

It is customary on Candlemas to bless candles. The candlelight is an outward and visible sign of Christ who illumines our heart and inner being.

With this in mind you are invited and encouraged to bring candles on February 2nd that you would like to have blessed during the Mass. Your candles can then be taken home and burned throughout the year.






Hawaii Catholic Engaged Encounter A Wedding is a day, a Marriage is a Life-time
