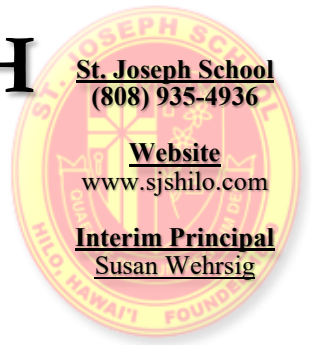

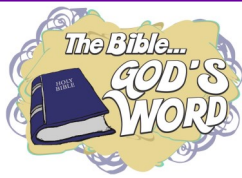

“Let them grow together until harvest “

When reading the evils being committed in society, don't we at times hope that God would simply eliminate all of those responsible. But then, if we will be honest with ourselves, should we not be afraid that we will be numbered among them for the wrongs that we have done?

We are just fortunate that we have a wise and merciful land-owner who believes in letting the weeds grow with the wheat because “ if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until harvest; then at harvest time I will say to the harvesters, ‘First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles for burning.’”

While the weed is given a reprieve, it is not tolerated. Just as evil is not tolerated and will have its just punishment. Hopefully for the wheat that struggles with the weed, it becomes stronger and is able to out-grow the weeds just as the good overcomes evil and the struggle against it, becomes a powerful witness to the grace of God at work in us. A Grace that can even transform the weed into becoming a wheat just as God's grace has transformed the lives of great sinners into powerful holy witnesses. After all, as St. Augustine tells us: “”There is no saint without a past nor is there a sinner without a future in God's love.

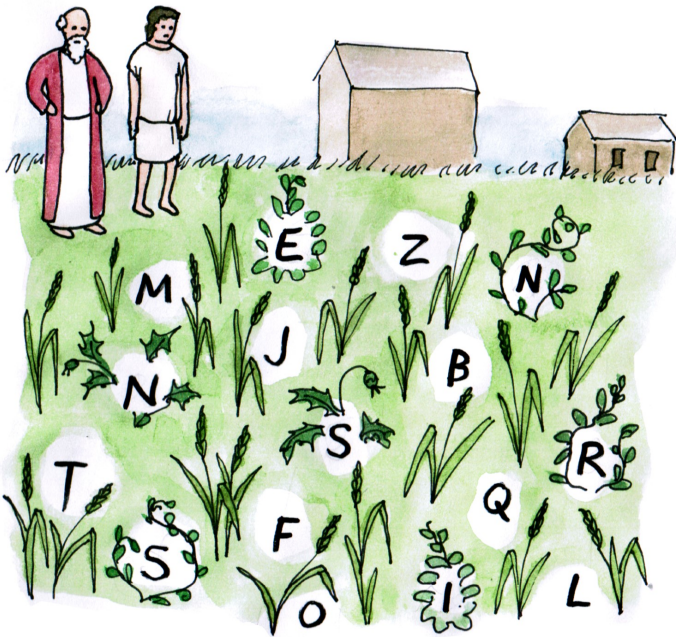
Announcement/Appointments:

Weeds Among the Wheat

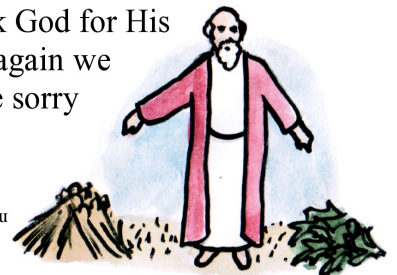


Weeds are plants that shouldn't be there. They use the sun and water that the good plants need. Have you ever helped pick weeds in the garden? In today's parable Jesus tells about a man who lets the weeds grow along with the wheat until harvest time, so that the good plants don't get pulled up along with the weeds.

The weeds represent the bad people, who will go to Hell at the final judgement. God lets them stay alive as long as the good people. He wants to give sinners lots of time to repent so that they can go to Heaven instead.



All the readings today are about God's mercy. God is the most powerful of all, but instead of destroying sinners He wants to give them more chances. When you think about it, you will realize God has already been merciful to all of us- because we have all sinned. We should thank God for His mercy, and if we do sin again we should show Him we are sorry by going to Confession.

ARRIVING AT MASS...(arrive no later than 10 minutes before Mass or forfeit your reservation)

UPON ARRIVAL, PLEASE SHOW YOUR RESERVATION CONFIRMATION TO THE FRONT DOOR HOSPITALITY TEAM. SOMEONE WILL ASSIST YOU IN LOCATING YOUR SEAT NUMBER. YOU MUST SANITIZE BEFORE ENTERING.

PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR SEATS AT ALL TIMES.

MASK TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

Only exceptions: priest-celebrant while he is speaking, and the lectors/cantors while they are reading/singing, and when you receive Holy Communion.

ALL WHO ATTEND MASS MUST MAINTAIN PROPER PHYSICAL DISTANCING (6 FEET)

HAND SANITIZER WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE ENTRANCE OF THE CHURCH, BUT YOU ARE ASKED TO BRING YOUR OWN AS WELL.

DURING MASS...

- THERE WILL BE NO MISSALETTES IN THE PEWS. YOU ARE FREE TO BRING YOUR OWN, BUT YOU MUST TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU.
- COLLECTION BASKETS WILL NOT BE PASSED YOUR OFFERING MAY BE PLACED IN THE DESIGNATED WOODEN OFFERING BOX AT THE FRONT ENTRANCE.
- THERE WILL BE NO OFFERTORY PROCESSION
- HOLDING HANDS DURING THE LORD'S PRAYER IS NOT ALLOWED
- DURING THE SIGN OF PEACE, YOU MAY SMILE, WAVE, BOW OR SHAKA TO YOUR NEIGHBOR (NO PHYSICAL CONTACT).

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION...

- ONLY THE BODY OF CHRIST WILL BE DISTRIBUTED
- USHERS WILL DIRECT YOU WHEN TO COME OUT OF YOUR PEW TO RECEIVE COMMUNION
- PLEASE MAINTAIN A 6 FOOT PHYSICAL DISTANCE FROM THE PERSON IN FRONT OF YOU; FOLLOW THE MARKINGS ON THE FLOOR
- YOU WILL RECEIVE COMMUNION ON THE HANDS ONLY TO PROTECT YOU, THE MINISTER AND THOSE WHO RECEIVE AFTER YOU.
- WHEN YOU COME FORWARD FOR COMMUNION, WEAR YOUR MASK OR FACE COVERING. WHEN RECEIVING: REMOVE YOUR FACE COVERING WHEN THE USHER INSTRUCTS, FLATTEN YOUR HANDS, CONSUME, COVER YOUR FACE AGAIN THEN RETURN TO YOUR SEAT
- PARISHIONERS IN THE DESIGNATED HANDICAPPED SEATS WILL RECEIVE COMMUNION AFTER ASSEMBLY FROM CLERGY

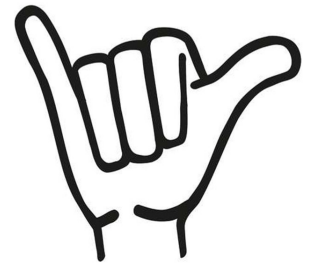
AFTER MASS...

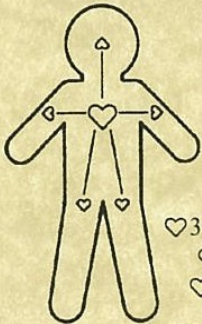
