#### "Whoever receives you receives me...."

Our Gospel today offers us some exhortation from Our Lord – some of which are easy to accept such as, "Whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones..., he will not lose his reward." While some of his teachings seem unreasonable, like "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me." It requires true faith to accept these hard teachings of Jesus and more so to live it.

It seems that we are asked to make a choice between God and our loved ones. But God does not make us choose between Him and others since God himself will be the first to insist that we love everyone. Neither does he want us to suffer unnecessarily when he says "whoever does not take up his cross and follow me is not worthy of me." The choice is between the good God wants us to do and the evil that the world proposes to us. It a choice for God and with God. A choice that we have to make even in the most simple act like giving a cup of cold water to a stranger who is thirsty.

And let us always remember that every good deed done to another person can very well be what we could be doing for Jesus who said: "Whoever receives you receives me, and he who receives me receives Him who sent me." Is not this the only reward that matters?



# WHAT TO EXPECT AND WHAT IS EXPECTED!

ARRIVING AT MASS...(arrive no later than 10 minutes before Mass or forfeit your reservation) UPON ARRIVAL, PLEASE SHOW YOUR RESERVATION CONFIRMATION TO THE FRONT DOOR HOSPITALITY TEAM. SOMEONE WILL ASSIST YOU IN LOCATING YOUR SEAT NUMBER. YOU MUST SANITIZE BEFORE ENTERING. PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR SEATS AT ALL TIMES.

## MASK TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

Only exceptions: priest-celebrant while he is speaking, and the lectors/cantors while they are reading/singing, and when you receive Holy Communion.
