

Nov. 1 – Solemnity of All the Saints – 2020 "Blessed are ... for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven."

This 31st Sunday falls on November 1st which is the Solemnity of all the Saints. As Catholics, we profess our belief in the Communion of Saints whom the Gospel calls blessed. And yet far from what the world considers as materially fortunate, these blessed ones are in fact poor, mourning, hungry, meek, merciful and persecuted. They are blessed because their time of liberation has arrived with the Kingdom of God. They are blessed because they received a blessing but at the same time they also have chosen to be a channel of blessings to others. They recognized that God has been gracious with them despite their unworthiness and they expressed their gratitude by leading others to encounter God through the witness of their lives. And where the love for god pervades, there is where heaven is!

Mistakenly we think that because they are called to be witness and example of blessedness, a saint most therefore be extraordinary or special in the way that they lived. But the truth is, the challenge is to do ordinary things filled with one's love for God. "It is not how much we do, but how much love we put in the doing. It is not how much we give, but how much love we put in the giving."

How much love are you willing to put into your words, action and way of dealing with our brothers and sisters? Are we capable of doing such? . St. John tells us: "See what singular love the Father has for us: we are called children of God, and we really are" (1Jn. 3:1).

Therefore, blank pages for the book will be located in the front office or located on the parish website. Parishioners may mail, drop off or place into the collection box their lists in sealed envelopes.


The Book of Life will be offered each Mass during the weekends of November.
