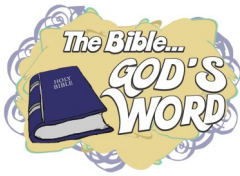

To each according to his ability

As we continue our reflection on the end time, this Sunday's Gospel reminds us of how we all will be required to do an accounting of the life that we lived. Have we lived our life to fullest? Or have we wasted it?

And Jesus knew how fear can be an obstacle to live our life to the fullest. For that reason, He always reminded his disciples "Be not afraid." And this is precisely what we see reflected in the attitude of the last servant in the parable. In contrast to the first two servant who was ready to take the risk when investing the money entrusted to them, the third servant was overcome with fear and played safe by hiding the money and do nothing with it. What he forgot is that this was not how the master intended him to use the money entrusted to him.

We are responsible for the gifts and talents entrusted to us by God. And he gave it to us for a purpose, that is, to use them to continue the work he started in creation – to make this world a reflection of His glory. We should not be afraid because when He gave it to us, He also knew what we are capable of doing with it. Therefore, as the saying goes, "Let's do it!"









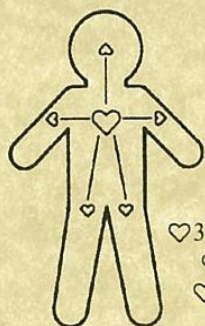
