

First Sunday of Advent – Year B (Dec. 2020) Be watchful! Be alert!"


On this First Sunday of Advent, we mark the beginning of the new liturgical year with the blessing and lighting of our first Advent Candle. Again we are invited to enter a period of joyful waiting for the coming of the Lord.

And this is not primarily about our anticipation of Christmas, which is a commemoration of the first coming of Jesus, when the "Word became flesh and dwelt among us." At that time Jesus came as Savior -- to save humankind from sin. But it is more about the second coming of the Lord in the "end time." where He as King of the Universe, will render to us fulfilment of everything He has promised.

But right now, we see ourselves between these two coming of Jesus. And we are being called to prepare and ready ourselves. How we are to prepare ourselves during this Advent season is made clear by Jesus with the Parable of the Watchful Servants who are asked to be on the watch for their master's unannounced return: "Be watchful! Be alert!"

This means we must be idle while we wait. In fact we are to be engaged in productive activity- to be diligent in carrying out the responsibilities entrusted to us. And while we do not know when He will finally come, we are given every day of our lives to practice the warm welcome we will accord to him as we encounter Him in the Eucharist and in "least of our brothers and sisters."


