Easter Message - 2021



Effective Easter Sunday, April 4 (or as of the Easter Vigil, April 3), Bishop Silva will be ENDING the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass.

Social gatherings are not permitted, and meetings held at the parish remain limited to no more than ten individuals.
