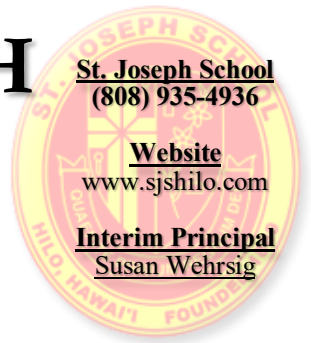

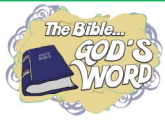

## 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary time – 2021 (B)

### “...He taught with authority!”

As Jesus preached at the synagogue, the people were astounded at His teaching" because He taught "as one having authority and not as the scribes. His capacity to speak with authority comes not from fluency nor mastery of speech but because He spoke with the voice of a prophet in whom the Lord has “put my words into his mouth; he shall tell them all that I command him. If any man will not listen to my words which he speaks in my name, I myself will make him answer for it." The authority comes from His faithfulness to the Word of God.

And furthermore, Jesus taught with authority because He lived what He preached. Many of us hold positions of authority - parents, employers, teachers, religious leaders, politicians, etc. It will all do us well to likewise be faithful to the voice of God that speaks to and through us. But this means we are familiar to His voice, have spent time understanding and meditating on it. But most important is to practice it in our everyday life. Otherwise we lose our moral authority over those placed under our care.

We might not be able to exorcise the demons possessing other people but we can be a witness of how we try to free ourselves with God’s grace from the many vices and sinful habits that have enslaved us. That hopefully will encourage others to do likewise.

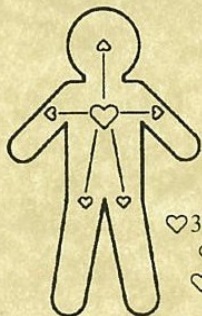
