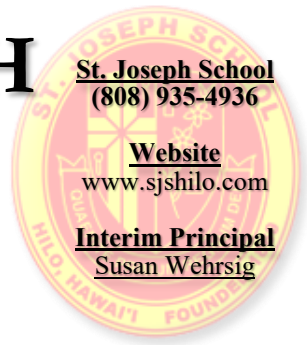

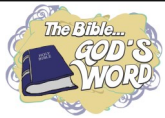

3rd Sunday of Lent – 2021 (B)

“I, the LORD, am your God...”

When asked which of the commandment is greatest, Our Lord Jesus without hesitation responded: “To love God and our neighbor!” For us Christians, therefore, “to love” is the essence of our being disciples. So that while we might not being engaged in something illegal or immoral or that violates the 10 commandments but neglect to act in love then we are not true to our calling as Christians.

The cleansing of the temple by our Lord is precisely inspired by this commandment of love. Jesus was not against people going to temple to worship. It is an outward expression of the people’s love for God. But when the priests of the temple turned this moment of loving worship to be an opportunity for financial profit. Not only did they forget to uphold worship as an act of love of God but that they have also taken advantage of the people who come to worship and failed to communicate God’s love for them. Thus, Jesus just felt he the need to restore temple worship to its true intention of encounter in love between God and humanity – thus driving out the merchants and money changers.

This Lenten journey hopefully enlightens us not to make our prayers a business deal with God like the merchants and the leaders of the temple. And likewise, be reminded that our fidelity to the 10 commandments is inspired by our true love for god expressed in our loving service to our brothers and sisters.

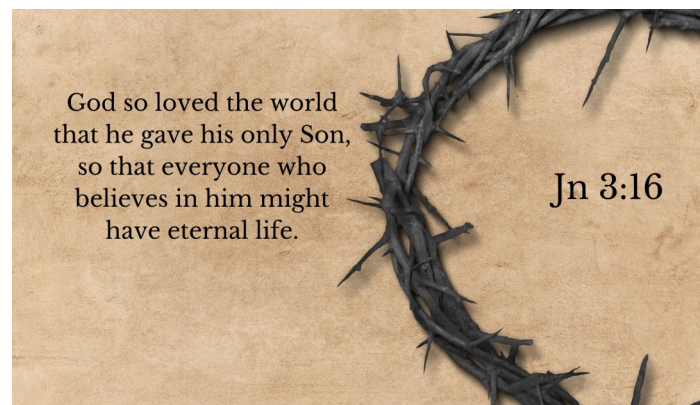

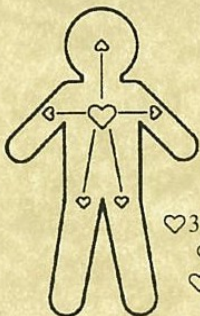
