“Whoever receives me...”

Who is the most important or the greatest person that you have welcomed into your homes?

This Sunday’s gospel reminds us that if we are to be true disciples of Our Lord, then we must be ready to welcome little children and be ready to serve our brothers and sisters particularly the least among us the way Jesus did. But why little children? A child has no social status nor influence. A child is a nobody. But it is the “nobody” that God takes a preferential option to care for because they have no one else to rely on.

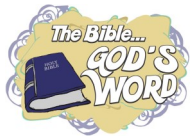
