



"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

This Sunday we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, the last day for the Christmas Season. Today's feast is considered the "second manifestation" of our Lord Jesus Christ after that of Epiphany. And for Our Lord Jesus this will be his entry to public ministry, But why was Jesus baptized? John is ministering the baptism of repentance and the people seek it for forgiveness for their sins. So what does this mean for Jesus, knowing that He is free from sin?

The Catechism tells us: "Jesus' gesture [of submitting to baptism] is a manifestation of self-emptying. The Spirit who had hovered over the waters of the first creation descended then on the Christ as a prelude to the new creation, and the Father revealed Jesus as 'his beloved Son' " (no. 1224).

And so Jesus went for baptism not for himself but for those "sinners" who are seeking their way back to God. He chose to identify with us in our movement towards God.

Yes, Jesus did not have to do it for He is always God's Beloved son on whom His favor rests. He did it to be in solidarity with us. He wants us to realize that we too are God's beloved sons and daughters and are called to a life of total union with God.

### **ANNUAL MEMORIAL MASS**


Although the annual Memorial Mass will not be celebrated this year due to the virus, we will remember and honor our parishioners and loved ones who died this past year.
