2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C – 2022

***“Do whatever He tells you.”***

After all the excitement of the Christmas Season, we return to what is known as the season of Ordinary Time. Stripped of all the holiday trimmings, it does not mean, however, that we also stash away the spirit of Christ being present among us. Rather we are challenged to be a witness to that Presence of Christ in the midst of the ordinary events of our everyday life. And this is the summon of Pope Francis of what it means to journey towards becoming a Synodal Church – a Church that truly reflects the Presence of Christ in the everyday life of the People of God.

At that wedding in Cana, we find the Lord Jesus being drawn into the domestic affairs of people. For the Lord nothing is so trivial that it would not merit his attention even if it is as insignificant as running out of wine. Every occasion can be a moment of grace if we allow His presence to prevail.

But fascinating as it is to see water transformed into wine by the Lord, it all started with Mary’s simple intervention. Her sensitivity to the predicament of others led her to be an instrument for the unfolding of the first sign of Jesus in the gospel. But she also was quick to remind us that the unfolding of the sign of the Kingdom of God can only happen if we “Do whatever He tells us to do.”
