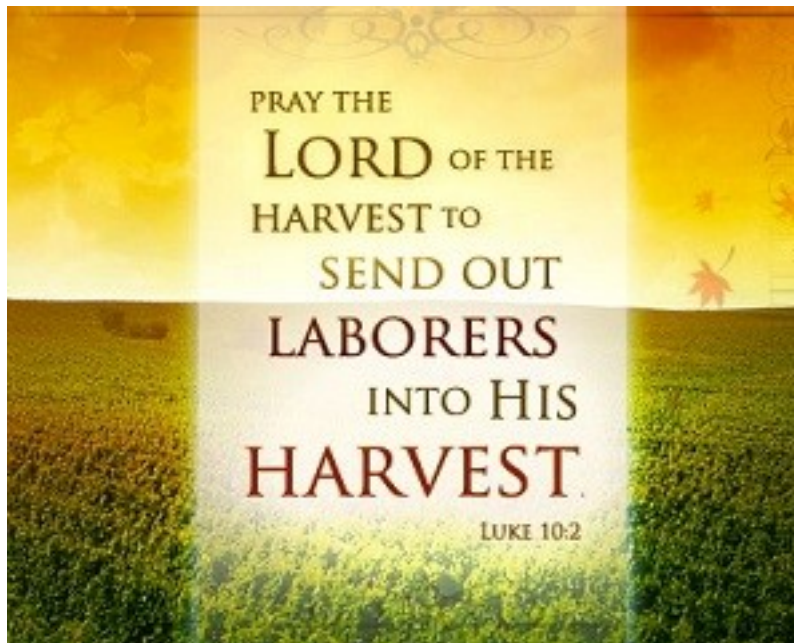

...to send out workers into his harvest

The Lord Jesus reminds us in the gospel for this Sunday of the importance of participating in His mission: “The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest.” This is both a grace and a responsibility!

Grace because the Lord himself is the one inviting us to share in His Mission. And He calls us to such an important task then He will definitely provide us with what we will need. But at the same time it is a responsibility that needs our whole-hearted commitment and trust in Him.

But fidelity and zeal for the Mission can only happen if we who are called to do so are convinced of the value of Our Lord’s message. We must be the first believer of the good news if we are to proclaim it to others. Otherwise they will only be empty words that will not change the hearts of those who will hear it.

And the first task of an evangelizer, bringers of the good news, is to pray! We must be men and women of prayer – who constantly and attentively listen to His words and discern His will for our world today.
