1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent – Year C – 2022 "If you are ..."

The Gospel every First Sunday of Lent will be the episode of the temptation of Christ in the desert. This is to help us prepare ourselves for another journey of a "return to the Lord" during this 40 days of prayer and penance. Recalling this event in the life of the Lord is intended to remind us not to be stunned if Satan will tempt us because Jesus was himself tempted. But how we will handle it is what matters.

But let us take a look on how Satan tried to lure Jesus. Satan began his tempting of Jesus by saying "If you are the Son of God..." The implication is why then must Jesus suffer if he is God's Son? And the same is true for all of us: "if you are God's beloved children..." then why do we have to undergo all kinds of sufferings and problems? Is he really a loving Father, who cares for His children or not?

Temptation is an ever-present reality in life. And every temptation is a choice to give in to what Satan is offering or to hold on to God and His unconditional love for us. Satan tried to seduce Jesus with comfort, with riches, and with power. But the good news is that Satan failed. Jesus chose to be faithful to His loving Father. And this is one of life's greatest lessons. We can say NO to Satan and NO to the temptation and choose to be faithful to God!




