Lord, Increase our faith!

We just are starting to free ourselves from the clutches of the COVID Pandemic that has brought unimaginable difficulties for a vast majority of people, but then natural calamities of all sorts – typhoons, earthquakes, drought, tsunamis, volcanic eruptions and floods have caused great sufferings and destruction in the lives and properties of people around the world. Not to mention the financial woes of people that has left many helpless and hopeless. One begins to wonder what kind of life lies ahead of us?

This Sunday's gospel points us to anchor ourselves in God – "Lord, Increase our faith!
