Duane Pavao leads the diocesan effort to collaborate with parishioners to build columbaria in our parishes across the state. Rev. Gomes walks through the process of building a new, cremation columbarium to meet the end-of-life needs in the St. Ann Catholic Church, Kaneohe community.

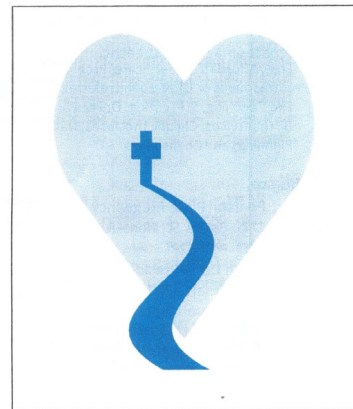
