Today’s gospel begins with Jesus taking his leave to be alone in order to pray. Jesus knew how important prayer is for his ministry and mission. And if it is true for Jesus how much more for us? Have we made Prayer a priority in our lives? Prayer brings us into God’s presence.

And, as in most cases, when Jesus is not close by, even the disciples are bound to experience being tossed by a storm. Without Jesus we can easily be lost and find our lives in chaos. We need Jesus to be with us in every step of our journeys. We need to hear his reassuring words: “Take courage it is I; do not be afraid.” We must focus on the Lord because once we lose focus, we lose heart. And we know how we can easily lose focus in the midst of troubled waters. Grippled by fear like Peter, we are paralyzed to be able to make another step. Our vision is blurred by darkness and we feel helpless to do anything. We focus on our powerlessness rather than on the Lord.

But it is precisely during those moments when the solid ground vanishes from beneath our feet and what we normally hold on to as our security is taken away. It is then that we have to rely on Christ – His Spirit, His Love, His Word. To walk with Jesus in the water is walking in faith. We must not doubt and instead must trust on the Love of Christ for us and let not fear take over our hearts.
