And I will give you rest

What do you do in order to rest? Go to a secluded place like the quiet nook by the bayfront? Or listening to the radio all day long or watching TV probably the whole evening? Or read a book? But if we really want to rest, do we ever go to the Lord and spend time in prayer?

Jesus in our gospel today says: “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened and I will give you rest.” When we approach the Lord and entrust to Him our cares – He is willing to help us with our burdens. The load becomes overwhelming when we try to carry it all by ourselves. But shared with Christ, then it becomes light.

However it is not a life of ease or a struggle-free living that Jesus promises us. We still have to take up our yoke but with Jesus carrying the yoke with us, then not only does He lighten our burden but we also can learn from Him. With Jesus, we learn to be free from useless worrying and see our struggles as an opportunity of growth and grace.

From Jesus we also learn to be meek and humble of heart. With meekness and humility, we learn to do away with competition and burdensome expectations. Instead what we see are opportunities for us to be a disciple and a channel of God’s graciousness to our brothers and sisters.
