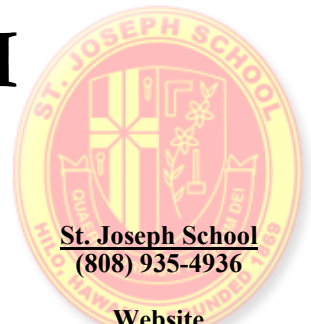

Solemnity of Corpus Christi - 2023

“Take and Eat, for this is my body which is given up for you.”

As we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus, we can be assured that there is nothing more that Jesus desires than that we partake of the life He offers. In His last meal with His friends which we read in the gospel and every eucharist thereafter, is reflected this desire of our Lord Jesus that we “Take and Eat, for this is my body which is given up for you.”

In the Eucharist, this is what Jesus is actually saying: “This bread is really for you. Only it is not simply bread. This is actually me for you.” Jesus gives all there is to give. And God that He is, Jesus is God giving himself completely to us. The Word became flesh to make us “partakers of the divine nature.”

In the Eucharist, Jesus is God for us, God with us, God within us. So that we can say that this Sacrament of the Body of the Lord is indeed the story of God who wants to come close to us. So close that he would allow Himself to be with us in the form of bread and wine that we might “Taste and see the goodness of the Lord”. Jesus chose to be close to us that there is nothing that stands between us and him; nothing that will separate us from him and he from us. This is how he wish to be remembered – so close yet so revealing...so human yet so divine.

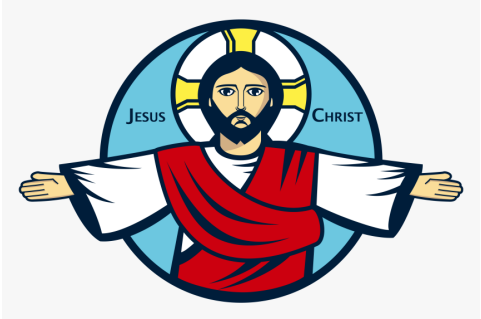

St. Joseph Church - Safety Tips for the month of June 2023

Review the emergency floor plan sheet in the pew locating your seat location, nearest exit to your seat, and the red lined directional routes to the nearest exit. The dotted black line in the middle of the church pm the floor plan represent midpoint where no crossing occurs when exiting during an emergency.
