Economists will say that there is nothing free in this world. Every gift being offered has a hidden agenda of demanding a return. So that while we all look forward receiving a gift, but on this age and time it is difficult to recognize when offered one especially if it is from a stranger or just casual acquittance. Consequently we fail to appreciate the gifts that has been given to us.

Today, fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. Today we receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. And yes, this is the day that we remember the coming down of the Spirit in the form of fire of tongues upon the apostles as they gather at the upper room as narrated to us in the Acts of the Apostles, empowering them to become the Church that Christ envisioned them to be. Thus, we likewise celebrate today the birthday of the Church.

But Pentecost was not just a sending of a Spirit but it was a discovery of the power and giftedness that they have been personally graced with. They had been hampered by their vision of a Messiah who would give them easy salvation and easy. But such an image was crushed when Jesus died on the cross and seemingly his enemies and their oppressors were the ones triumphant. But it all changed when they finally realized Jesus rose again. Then they were able to see the real Jesus and the real message that had been there all the time. But now that he had risen some were returning to the old hopes. So likewise for us, today is the feast of the discovery of our own giftedness and celebrating it. To celebrate is to be grateful to the source of the gifts and to make sure we use the gifts in a manner that give glory to the giver.
